INVITED **FEDERATIONS** Only gymnasts in good standing with the correct age and holding a valid FIG License by the time of registration until the end of the competitions may participate. The Local Organizing Committee will be responsible for checking the validity of the gymnasts Licenses. No gymnast will be accepted without a valid FIG License at the time of the event. JUDGES AND JURIES	All judges must have a current valid FIG brevet at the time of the event for the respective discipline (RGI and/or RGG).
	The Organizing Member Federation will apply a fine of CHF 2'000 per missing judge, should a federation fail to bring the required number of judges. This fine must be paid to the LOC by 6th March 2020.
REGISTRATION DEADLINES	The definitive and nominative deadlines are compulsory. Definitive registration: March, 6 th , 2020 (2 months prior to the event) Nominative registration April, 6 th , 2020 (4 weeks prior to the event)
ENTRY FEES	The not refundable cost for the Entry/Registration Fee is:
	30 EUR per gymnast
	55 EUR per all other participants (except judges)
	At the time of the Definitive Registration 100% of the entry fee must be paid to the LOC. Entry fees must be paid by 6 th March and according to the number of persons registered in the Definitive Form. Entries without payment of the entry fees will be considered as invalid and will be refused.
ACCREDITATION	Accreditation cards will be given at the LOC Office at "Portimão Arena" by the arrival of the Delegations. A photo of each member of the delegation (in electronic format – JPEG – must be sent to the LOC together with the nominative registration – 6 th April 2020). Photos taken upon arrival will be charged of EUR 20 each.

EVENT FORMAT	This International Tournament consist in: • Seniors: Individual Competition - Qualifications/All-Around Competition; - Apparatus Finals: the top eight Seniors gymnasts per apparatus (2 per Country) from the Qualifications will participate in the Finals. - In addition, the Organising Member Federation may participate in the four finals with one gymnast, at its free choice. This Wild Card gymnast will have to start first.
	 Juniors: Individual Competition Individual Qualification: Each country can participate with the number of gymnasts that desires, NO LIMIT for Individual gymnasts; Apparatus Finals _ The top eight Junior gymnasts per apparatus (one per Country) from the Qualifications will participate in the Finals. In addition, the Organising Member Federation may participate in the four finals with one gymnast, at its free choice. This Wild Card gymnast will have to start first. Team: each team must have between 2 and 4 gymnasts (only one team per Country count for the Teams ranking); they must perform the total of 8 routines – 2 per apparatus. Each Federation can participate with more than 1 Team. However in the final rankings only one team per Federation will be included (the Team with

INSURANCE	The Host Federation, the LOC and the FIG will not be held responsible for any liabilities in case of accidents, illness, repatriation and the like. The FIG Technical Regulations foresee that all participating Federations are responsible for making their own arrangements to have the necessary valid insurance coverage against illness, accidents and for repatriation for all the members of their Delegation. The LOC will verify the insurance upon arrival of the delegation members

INTERNATIONAL TRANSPORTATION	The invited participating federations must pay for the International travel costs of their delegation members. Arrival destination airport: FAO, Faro, Portugal . The Travel Schedule Form must be returned to the LOC by 6 th
