INVITED FEDERATIONS	<p>The Pan American Gymnastics Union invites all Federations affiliated to the PAGU and the FIG and which are up to date in their obligations.</p>
AGES	<p>Seniors: 15 years and older*</p> <p>Junior: 13-20 years* (maximum age difference between the partners is 6 years)</p> <p>Age Group 2: 12–19 years* (maximum age difference between the partners is 6 years)</p> <p>Age Group 1: 11–17 years* (maximum age difference between the partners is 5 years)</p> <p><i>*Age by December 31, 2021</i></p> <p>All gymnasts must have a valid FIG license until the end of the event.</p>
JUDGES AND JURIES	<p>All judges must have a current valid FIG brevet at the time of the event.</p> <p>Each Federation with FIG brevet judges must send at least 1 judge and a maximum of 2 judges as follows:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Federations with 1 or 2 units participating, and with FIG brevet judges, must participate with at least 1 judge (compulsory) from categories 1, 2, 3 or 4. • Federations with 3 or more units participating, and with FIG brevet judges, must participate with 2 judges (compulsory) from categories 1, 2, 3 or 4. • If a Federation has a judge of Category 3 or higher, they must present at least one judge of the higher category, and then they may present a Category 4 judge. <p>These judges are in addition to any CJP/DJ selected for the competition. The CJP will be a neutral judge invited by PAGU for the competition.</p> <p>The CJP and 1 D judge must be of Category 2 or higher.</p>

	<p>Federations with PAGU TC member may register him in addition to the judges of their Federation.</p> <p>The panel may have two judges from the same federation in active positions, but they must be in separate components. It is preferred to have one judge as DJ and the other as E or A. But it is possible to have 1 as E and 1 as A, if necessary, to complete the panel. Category 4 judges will be assigned to an E judging position as a first priority.</p> <p>The fine for failing to participate with the required number of judges is USD\$1,000.00, per missing judge and must be paid to PAGU by <u>September 15, 2021</u> at the latest.</p> <p>Federations that do not have FIG brevet judges and that participate for the first time in an official PAGU event, are exempt from the fine. EVENT FORMAT	<p>The Pan American Championship consists of two phases: Qualifications and Finals in all categories and age groups.</p> <p>Unless noted otherwise, the competition will follow FIG Rules for Seniors, Juniors, Age Group 1 and Age Group 2.</p> <p>Description of each phase, results determination method and tie breaking rules can be consulted in the PAGU Technical Regulations 2020 edition.</p> <p>Qualifications Qualification for Balance and Dynamic Finals and to receive a ranking for All Around. Qualifications may be entered by all pairs or groups, including specialists, intending to qualify for Finals. And by all pairs and groups intending to receive a ranking for the All Around.</p> <p>Finals – Balance and Dynamic for all Age Groups, Juniors and Seniors The number of pair/groups (P/G) in finals is determined by the total number of units based on the nominative entries as follows:</p> <table> <tr> <td>1 – 8 P/G</td><td>6 finalists</td></tr> <tr> <td>9 – 15 P/G</td><td>8 finalists</td></tr> <tr> <td>16 – 20 P/G</td><td>10 finalists</td></tr> <tr> <td>20 + P/G</td><td>12 finalists</td></tr> </table> <p>Not more than 2 pair/groups (with highest score) per federation may proceed to the final.</p> <p>All-around Final - Combined Age Group 12-19, Juniors and Seniors (not 11-17) The event can be entered by all pairs and groups that have taken part in Qualifications. The total scores from the Qualifications and All Around will be used to rank the competitors. Note: Not more than 2 pair/groups (with highest score) per federation may proceed to the final.</p> <p>The Junior and Senior competitors with the highest total scores from Qualifications and All Around will be declared the winners and all-around Pan American Champions. For Age Group 12-19, the pair/group with the highest total scores from Qualification and All Around will be declared the winners and the 12-19 Pan American Age Group Champions. 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	In AG1, the score to take into consideration is the sum of the Balance and Dynamic scores the pair/group obtained during the Qualification. In AG2, Junior and Senior, the score to take into consideration is the sum of the Balance and Dynamic scores the pair/group obtained during the Qualification plus the score obtained in the Combined exercise during the All Around Final.

MEDICAL SERVICES	The Local Organizing Committee will provide first aid and ambulance at competition and training sites during the official activities.
COVID-19	<p>All participants will take a rapid COVID-19 test upon arrival to the official hotels and must stay in their rooms until the results of the tests are ready. During the trainings and competition periods all participants are allowed to circulate only in the assigned sport venues, as well as in the official hotels.</p> <p>If this test results positive, the member of the delegation must take a PCR test at its own charge to confirm or deny the given positive result.</p> <p>Besides the medical guidelines for the event, FIG also requires all the participants to follow the standard precautions. The FIG requires all participants, judges and officials to take standard precautionary measures, such as frequent hand-washing, wearing masks or face coverings at all times and keeping a physical distance of at least 1.5 meters whenever possible.</p> <p>The only situation in which the safety distance does not have to be respected is when a coach provides assistance (catch, lead, spotting) during an athlete's</p>

	<p>performance. This phase must be kept as short as possible, and the assisting person is obliged to wear a mask throughout.</p> <p>Gymnasts do not need to wear a mask or face covering while they are performing at the training venue or on the FOP and must keep a physical distance of at least 1.5 meters whenever possible.</p> <p>Additional information will be included in the Work Plan that will be sent to the Federations prior to the event.</p>
VISA	<p>Please verify immediately with your travel agency or Colombian Embassy or Consulate in your country if a visa is required for your travel to Colombia.</p> <p>The Local Organizing Committee will be happy to assist each Delegation member with an official invitation letter, provided that this request is made before <u>October 15, 2021</u> to the LOC.</p> <p>The request must include the function, full name, gender, date of birth, citizenship, passport number, passport expiry date, the arrival and departure dates of the Delegation member, as well as the city the visa application support letter must be sent to.</p>
INSURANCE	<p>The Host Federation, the Local Organizing Committee, the PAGU and the FIG will not be held responsible for any liabilities in case of accidents, illness, repatriation and the like.</p> <p>The FIG Technical Regulations foresee that all participating Federations are responsible for making their own arrangements to have the necessary valid insurance coverage against illness, accidents and for repatriation for all the members of their Delegation.</p> <p>The LOC will verify the insurance upon arrival of the delegation members (e.g. cover note or photocopy of the valid policy). Delegation members with insufficient insurance coverage must inform the LOC in advance, but no later than <u>October 15, 2021</u>.</p> <p>The LOC will subsequently offer insurance at the Federations own charge as follows: USD\$50.00 per person for the official days of the event.</p>


